Accommodations

Sleeps eight owners and guests in four staterooms with four en suite baths, plus a day head on the main deck. The private owners suite is amidships, with king size berth and his and hers heads. The crew quarters are aft, with a separate captain's cabin with double berth and an additional single berth above, plus head and shower. The crew cabin with single twin berth also has its own head and shower.

Vessel walkthrough

Warm Cherry wood cabinetry accented by walnut burl and black lacquer is throughout the boat. The woodwork is Beidermeyer design styled and maintained in a rich rubbed satin finish. The vessel has plenty of natural light on the main and upper decks due to her large and abundant windows.

Entering the salon from the aft deck, the glass sliding doors open into the main salon seating area, which features a plush upholstered L-shaped sofa and occasional chairs surrounding a designer cocktail table. To the aft starboard corner is the entertainment center and cabinetry that follows forward up the entire length of the salon past the dining area. Forward of the salon lounge the formal dining area is separated by a cabinet console housing china and flatware. The spacious dining area is engaged by the full floor to ceiling mural art of a great hall on the forward wall. To the portside just forward is the entrance to the day head and portside entrance foyer. To the starboard side is a larger foyer area with double doors that open to the side deck. Also here there are stairs leading up to the raised pilothouse/sky lounge area and further up to the enclosed flybridge. This stairway area had the ceilings opened, which gives this boat's arrangement a unique feel of spaciousness. Back on the main deck there is also a stairway just forward that affords privacy down to the master stateroom area.

Forward on the starboard side beyond the stairs you enter the galley area and Country kitchen lounge. A large and practical galley is well appointed with granite countertops and plentiful Cherry wood cabinetry. A large pantry to the port side includes a commercial sized refrigeration cabinet. Ahead of the galley is a large table perfect for informal meals and gathering. It is bordered by a dinette-styled settee with additional chairs on the aft side.

To the portside forward is a stairway down to the guest accommodations. At the bottom of the stairs and forward is the VIP stateroom with a centreline queen berth and en suite head. Turning aft down the companionway is a laundry cabinet to one side followed by similar sized en suite guest staterooms to



port and starboard at the end of the hall. Portside has a double berth and the starboard guest has twin berths.

Back to the main deck and down the private stairway to the master stateroom is a marble floored entrance foyer before the full-beam stateroom. This stateroom has a centreline king berth with finely detailed and decorative accessories throughout. Just aft is separate doors to his and hers bath with Jacuzzi tub and shower between the sides. Again this area affords tremendous attention to detail.

The crew and captain's quarters are aft and accessed through a separate door from the Euro-transom platform area.

Pilothouse

The pilothouse lounge refers on this vessel to the area which would occupy the raised pilothouse helm on a non-enclosed flybridge vessel. This area is a highlight of the boat and a very comfortable location to reside while cruising. A raised L-shaped, plushly upholstered settee surrounds a Cherry wood inlaid cocktail table, wood bookcase & writing desk, and also a Sharp Aquos 17" LCD color flat panel TV. Beneath the settee is a polished stainless foot rail and the desk has a swing-out leather cushioned stool. On the aft wall is a framed nautical chart of Bermuda. The stairway leading from the main deck up and past to the enclosed bridge is all open and has a polished stainless and wood banister. There is a mesh windshield screen wrapping the exterior windows that is kept on at most times.

Day head: Situated to the port side forward of the dining area by the portside entrance foyer; includes a black granite vanity with under-mounted white porcelain and gold inlaid sink

VIP Stateroom Forward

Down the forward guest quarters stairway, the VIP stateroom is forward and includes an en suite head with large shower. The circular stainless steel port lights to either side are dressed with navy blue curtains. There are abundant drawer and cabinet storage to either side and below the bed. The large hanging locker has a full-length mirror on the back side of the door. The head has a granite vanity top with under-mounted Kohler sink and Cherry wood cabinetry. The mirror with florescent lighting hides the medicine cabinet.

Twin berth stateroom with a wood finished nightstand between. Finely crafted wood headboards have black lacquer trim that flows into the wall and bed stands. There are mirrors above the headboards and



white padded wall panels contrast with the wood cabinetry. The porthole to the starboard side is treated with a retractable Roman shade. En suite head is forward with finely trimmed granite vanity top with under-mount sink, designer fixtures and Cherry wood cabinetry. A large shower compartment has a folding door enclosure.

Master stateroom, amidship

The full-width Master Stateroom Amidships is accessed by a private stairway on the starboard side. The centreline king berth has nightstands to either side with three drawers below in each. In the forward side of the stateroom are two walk-in cedar lined closets. Dresser drawers (six) are to either side and to the portside is a desk/vanity which opens with make-up lights and mirror. To the starboard side is an upholstered reading couch. In a cabinet is a U-line drink refrigerator and Amsec security safe.

Master bath is full-beam in a his and hers arrangement with a large shower/Jacuzzi tub in the center separating the sides. The toilets are in closed rooms at either end with shaded portholes. The granite vanities have under-mounted gold painted enamel designer sinks. There are heated towel bars, mirrored ceilings and medicine cabinets. Behind a door in the shower cabinet is an emergency exit door to the engine room.

This area is accessed by a transom platform door that opens to four-steps down a companionway, which leads to the engine room as well. Also along this companionway is the stacked washer/dryer.

PONT:

Flybridge/Sky lounge

The enclosed flybridge has good visibility through its large tinted windows and is accessed from an inside stairway along the starboard side. The helm station is centerline forward with a large bench-style helm seat with stainless foot rail and helm wheel. There is room to stand comfortably and lean back while at the wheel. To the portside forward is a navigator's desk with a beige cushioned companion chair by Tracy Marine. Just behind the helm area on a raised platform is a large C-shaped settee lounge to the portside, and Cherry wood cabinetry to the starboard side housing the entertainment centre/TV and refreshment centre. There is a custom wood inlaid hollow table in the lounge area and blinds are fitted to each window and door. Chart drawers are built into the back edge of the settee (facing the nav desk area). The settee is luxuriously upholstered in patterned beige glove leather and has a tailored cover that protects it in daily use. A sliding glass door to the aft side starboard leads to the boat deck. Here the overhang above extends back for shade and rain cover. In an outside cabinet are two Jennaire grill tops and a sink/prep area. To the railing on either side are the wing areas and hinge-down control stations. Beneath is a hidden fire control station. To the portside a small ladder leads to an access hatch to the bridge top. Aft to the starboard side is an access for the covered stairway with banister down to the aft deck. The enclosed bridge forward facing windows are serviced by five windshield wipers and washers plus defoggers on the inside. Air-conditioning is vented through a Cherry wood overhead valance and low voltage lighting is available for mood setting. There is white padded Magelite wall coverings with the windows framed in Cherry wood moldings.

In the electronics room beneath the pilothouse stairway there are four separate Sony satellite TV receivers and Channel Vision multi-room video switchers. There are also UPS backups for the onboard computer systems.

Curved stairway down to the platform from the starboard side of the aft deck has night lighting and a stainless banister plus ample grab rails by the aft quarters door and outboard towards the hull sides.

Removable stainless swimming ladder and pop-up stainless tender cleats

Transom water-tight entry door for captains/crews quarters and engine room

Raised U-shaped sun-lounge area, surrounded with stainless safety railings leading from the forward non-skid, lighted stairway

Foredeck V-shaped bench-style riding seat (in forepeak) with evening lighting and stereo speakers

Aft deck

The large open aft deck area has teak deck (2006) and a bench-style settee aft with Sunbrella canvas covered cushions and white canvas covers. A large rectangular-shaped fiberglass table, which has a



hollow base, opens with a table top hinge for useful storage space. There are chairs with matching cushions that make it possible to seat eight at the table.

To the starboard side of the settee is a curved stairway down to the Euro-transom platform and aft watertight door. Forward from the aft deck are the large polished stainless framed sliding glass doors opening to the salon. To the starboard side of the salon doors is a teak stairway leading up to a door that opens on the boat deck area of the flybridge. The aft deck area and stairways are secured by welded stainless hand rails and banisters. The deckhouse overhead extends aft to fully cover the rear settee, and Canteloupe lighting fixtures provide plenty of evening illumination. Open forward to either side of the deckhouse are the wide and covered walk-around side decks. Also to the rear corners of the aft deck are polished stainless hausers, bollards and Maxwell line windlasses. Aft deck cushions and the forward sun pad area are covered in charcoal, black & white striped canvas.

Hull

Awlcraft paint

Full walk-around non-skid decks with high bulwarks and large self-draining scuppers. Heavy-duty stainless capped rub-rail, forward up at the shear line, quarter-ship at mid-hull height, and at platform level around the stern.

Fueling inlet area is on the port side and all tanks have cam-lock fittings and are inside an indented spill containment area with door. Flagstaff is mounted off the aft edge of the flybridge boat deck.

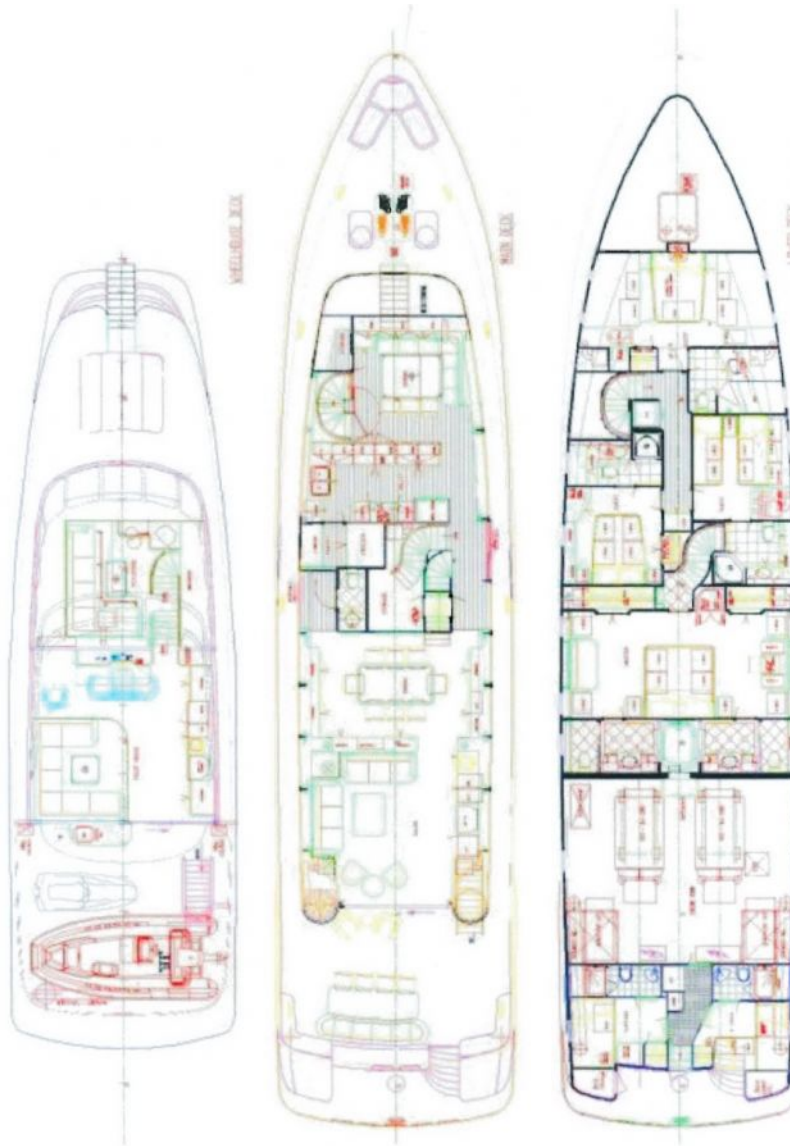
