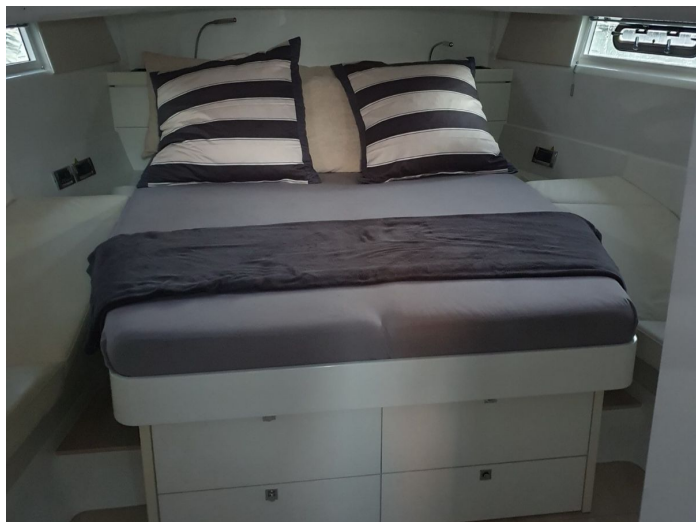

/ GRP deck, isophthalic gelcoat, 1st layer vinyl ester resin. Stainless steel tie bar for fender. Large diameter stainless steel handrails, 2 gates at stern. Fold out stairs on port side and starboard bulwark. Upholstery in light grey - 2 Cockpit "U"-shaped sofa, rear one with hinged backrest. Sunpad at bow with seating bench. Pilot and copilot seats with hinged bolster.
2 cockpit tables with electric high/low leg and cover, convertible into sunpad.
